

We rarely close the school because of snow. We aim to make a decision as early as possible but not too early as sometimes early indications may be that we won't have many staff but this sometimes changes as traffic & public transport begins to move.

There are several ways to check whether the school is open or closed during periods of bad weather:

Parents need to do their own risk assessment and decide whether it is safe to make the journey to school. If you decide that it is too dangerous to travel please let us know after 9am, or earlier if using email.

If it snows and the school is open the children may be able to play in the snow and build snow men but they can only go out if they have waterproof boots. Trainers will not be sufficient.
