#### **Reception Class**

## Topic - Sorrow & Joy

\* Understand that we are capable of hurting others and that we should always try to be kind to each other

- \* Know that we can say sorry when we hurt someone but we need to ask Jesus to help us to do this
- \* Know that we need to ask Jesus to help us to be kind to others
- \* Know that Jesus forgave those who hurt him.
- \*Know that we can forgive other people when they hurt us

#### Year 1

## **Topic - Following Jesus**

\*Hear how Jesus chose some of the first disciples and consider how we choose friends

\*Hear the story of the Good Samaritan and reflect on the message it has for us as followers of Jesus \*Hear the story of Jesus and his followers going into Jerusalem and think of how we can show that we 'welcome' Jesus \*Know that Jesus died on Good Friday and God raised him from the dead three days later and explore the hope this gives us

# Topic - The Mass \*Know and reflect on the importance of the celebration of the Mass \*Know about the readings at Mass and why we should listen to them Know that at the Offertory we offer gift to God \*Know and appreciate that at the Consecration the bread and wine are changed into Jesus

## Topic – Eucharist

\*Know why Sunday is special for Christians, identify ways that we can make Sunday a special day

\*Know that we come to Mass to hear the teaching of Jesus and pray to him

\*Learn some of the responses in the Mass

\*Know that in the Mass we offer thanks to God the Father for the gift of his Son,

\*Appreciate all that we have to be thankful for

\*Know that during the Mass the bread and wine become the body and blood of Jesus

\*Know that when we receive Holy Communion we receive Jesus

\*Know that Jesus is present in the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle

\*Understand that Jesus died on the cross, and rose again, to save us from sin

\*Understand how we should behave at Mass and be aware of the most sacred parts of the Mass

#### Year 5

## **Topic - Reconciliation**

\*Know that sin is a failure of love

\*Know that when we sin we hurt ourselves and others and damage our relationship with God

\*Reflect on what strengthens our friendship with God and others and what damages it

\*Understand that God loves and forgives us if we are truly sorry

\* Reflect on times when we have shown or have been shown love and forgiveness

\*Know that God heals our friendship with him and others through the Sacrament of Reconciliation

\*Know how we can prepare ourselves to receive this Sacrament

\*Know what happens during the Sacrament of Reconciliation

\*Know that this Sacrament enables us to change our behaviour

\*Make the Stations of the Cross

## Year 6

# Topic – Jesus, Son of God

\*Know that Jesus' miracles led many to believe that he was the Son of God and think about what that means for us

\*Understand why Jesus washed the disciples' feet and reflect on the meaning this has for us

\*Know about the Passion and Death of Jesus and consider its importance for us \*Understand and reflect on what the resurrection of Jesus means for us

## Year 4

#### Topic – Jesus the Saviour

\*Know that Jesus came to share our life so that we can share his life

\*Reflect on how we can share in the life of Jesus

\*Know and appreciate that Jesus is truly God and, as man, truly human

\*Know that Jesus came to show us the way to live

\*Know that when Jesus died on the cross he took away our sins

\*Know what happened in Holy Week

\*Know what happened on Easter Sunday and reflect on the importance of the resurrection for us
