<u>Terms of Reference</u> <u>Curriculum Committee</u>

- 1. The Curriculum Committee should meet at least once each term.
- 2. Make recommendations to the Governing Body in relation to the curriculum.
- 3. Develop monitoring and evaluation strategies to ensure that the national curriculum and its assessment arrangements are being implemented in the school.
- 4. Inform the Governing Body accordingly on targets that should be set for pupil attainment. This includes ensuring that procedures are in place for the collection and analysis of data on pupil attainment.
- 5. Ensure that appropriate information is provided by the school to the Curriculum Committee about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced.
- 6. Ensure that the requirements of children with special educational needs are met.
- 7. Ensure that the required information about school performance is published through the information sheets, on the school website and in the brochure.
- 8. Contribute to the school improvement plan
- 9. Agree curriculum policies and inform the Governing Body.
- 10. Ensure that a true and accurate written record of all proceedings of the committee is maintained.
- 11. Review the policy and provision for collective worship and for religious education every 2 years and make recommendations in line with the governors annual yearly planner
- 12. Review the following policies safeguarding and child protection, anti-bullying, special educational needs, relationships and sex education in line with the governors annual planner
- 13. Review SEN policy spring term in line with the governor's annual planner.
