In Year 3 the emphasis will be on developing the independent learner, establishing good work habits and fostering a caring and co-operative attitude towards one another.

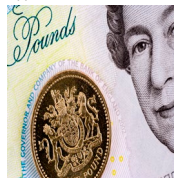
