

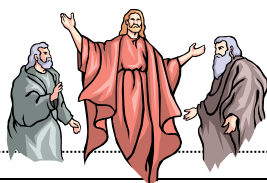


Year 5 Curriculum Information Spring Term

Year 5 is a challenging year when the children mature, gaining confidence and independence. They develop into responsible, considerate and thoughtful individuals ready for their final year in primary school.

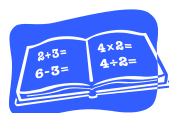

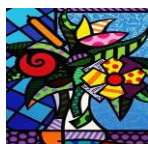
