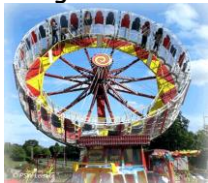

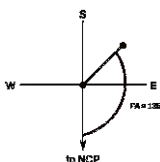
- Read regularly with your child every day
