Dear parents and families,

We are pleased to inform you that our Christmas Fair will be starting at 2pm on Thursday 7th December and will run until 4:30pm.

We are offering families the opportunity to collect children early on that day, so that they can attend the Christmas Fair during the afternoon. We have organised a staggered collection time for the day. Please note that siblings may be collected at the same time. The early collection is not compulsory; children will remain in school until the usual time, unless you decide to collect them early.

Please see below for the optional early collection times for each class.

- **Reception Class** children may be collected from 1:50pm from their usual end of day collection point.
- Years 1 and 2 children may be collected from 2pm.

Year 1 may be collected from their usual end of day collection point.

Year 2 may be collected from this same point – the exit with the ramp, rather than the usual end of

day collection point.

• Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 children may be collected from 2:15pm from the middle doors.

If your child has permission to go home on their own, they will not be dismissed until 3:15pm.

We will host numerous exciting stalls at the Christmas Fair. Please note that it will be a **cash-only** event, so kindly start saving your coins!

We have a fabulous raffle with prizes being added continually. Tickets for the raffle and Santa's Grotto will be available for purchase before/after school under the canopy area every day next week. Alternatively, you may buy tickets from the school office.

A big round of applause and a resounding thank you to all the incredible organizers and helpers who made our recent school disco an unforgettable evening!


