Year 2 – Damilola for working really hard in literacy and numeracy.

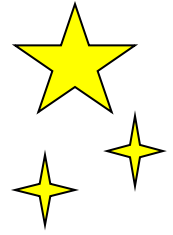
Year 3 – Julian for working hard at proofreading and editing his literacy work.
