Dear Parents and Families,

I'm pleased to share that new gates have now been installed, which prevent unauthorised access from the playground to the grounds behind the school building. This addition is an important step in strengthening our safeguarding measures, while also making drop-off and pick-up times for breakfast club, after-school club, and other events more convenient for families.

Parents can now come onto the playground to drop off or collect children attending clubs, helping to ease busy times. Importantly, this new arrangement still ensures the school building remains secure and protected from unannounced visitors.

This means that from now on, parents can drop off children for **breakfast club any time after 7:30am**.

Movie Night – Tuesday

A reminder that our next Movie Night will take place on Tuesday. This time, the children have chosen to watch *Mufasa: The Lion King* – a popular choice we know they'll enjoy!

As with previous events, the timings and collection arrangements remain the same:

- **Infant Movie Night** will start at **2:00pm** and finish at **4:00pm**
- **Junior Movie Night** will start at **4:15pm** and finish at **6:30pm**
- All children attending Movie Night should be collected from the Junior playground (computer room).

Please note that **Junior** children must be collected from school at 3:15pm and brought back to school at 4:15pm for the movie night. They may not stay on the school premises between 3:15 and 4:15pm.

Details:

- **Cost:** £5 (includes a drink and a hot dog)
- **Tickets:** On sale in the school playground, before and after the school day.
- **Optional:** Children can bring a pillow and/or blanket to make themselves cosy during the movie. Please send these in a **named bag**.
- **Dietary Requirements:** If your child has specific dietary needs, please let us know in advance.

If your **Infant** child chooses not to attend, they will remain in school with their teacher until 3:15pm, as usual.

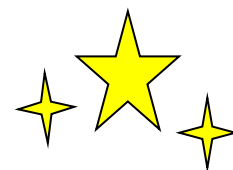
Thank you for your continued support in helping to make our school events safe, enjoyable and inclusive for everyone.
