With the summer holidays just around the corner, I want to take a moment to reflect on an incredible year—especially for our Year 6 pupils.

Throughout their time at St Vincent’s and especially this year, they have shown us what it truly means to *“Live, Love and Learn Through Christ”*. They have been outstanding role models—living out our school values of *Love, Forgiveness, Compassion, Curiosity, Resilience, and Aspiration* each day.

They’ve taken on responsibilities with real maturity, especially in the way they have supported our younger children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Their kindness, patience and care have made a real difference and they leave a legacy of leadership that others will follow.

This year, our Year 6 pupils rose brilliantly to the challenge of their SATs. I am incredibly proud to share their results with you:

- **Reading: 84%** met the expected standard (*37% at greater depth*)
- **Writing: 91%** met the expected standard (*16% at greater depth*)
- **Maths: 97%** met the expected standard (*37% at greater depth*)
- **Combined Reading, Writing and Maths: 81%**

At this time, national figures for 2025 have not yet been released. For reference, last year’s national averages (2024) were:

- **Reading: 73%, Writing: 71%, Maths: 73%, and Combined: 61%.**

Based on these comparisons, we are expecting to remain **above national averages in all subjects once this year’s figures are published**. These excellent outcomes reflect the children’s hard work, resilience and positive attitude—as well as the skill and dedication of our staff and the invaluable support of families. We are proud not just of the results, but of the character and teamwork they have shown along the way.

As they prepare to move on to secondary school, we know they go forward ready for the next chapter—with strong foundations, a growing sense of who they are, and a faith that will continue to guide them.

To our Year 6 families, thank you for your support over the years—and to our children, thank you for everything you’ve brought to St Vincent’s. You will always be part of our school family.

May you always walk your journey with God by your side, and may His love guide your every step.

Well done to all our children and staff for a fantastic year. Have a safe, restful, and joyful summer!
