- White short or long-sleeved shirt
- Light blue school tie (*)
- Grey tailored long trousers or grey pinafore dress/skirt
- Navy V-neck jumper or cardigan (*)
- Grey socks for trousers
- White socks for skirts/dresses or grey or navy tights
- Plain black shoes
- Black or navy coat

(*) Navy v-neck jumpers and cardigans with the school logo are available from the school office as well as school ties, school bags and summer hats.

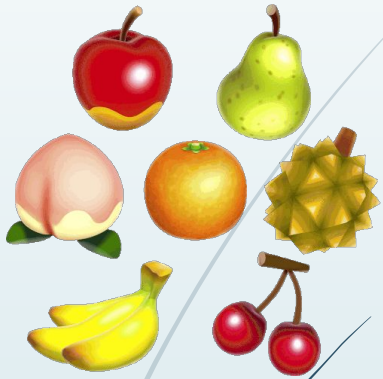


What the children will need daily

Outdoor clothing
